A GUIDE TO SCHOOL SUPPORT AND ACIS TRAVEL

We're thrilled you are considering bringing your students overseas for an educational experience!

What role does your school play in your travel plans? That depends!

We like to provide 3 categories to define how your trip can be organized with relation to your school.

SCHOOL SPONSORED

Your school board has approved your tour and your trip represents the school.

SCHOOL SUPPORTED

You may or may not have school board approval but your school still supports the trip.

INDEPENDENT

Your group is traveling independent of the school.

WHERE CAN I PROMOTE MY TRIP?

Use your classroom and other public spaces to share information, host meetings, and recruit new travelers. You can also accommodate informational sessions outside of school at local coffee shops and public libraries. We recommend nominating a student advocate for the trip who can help spread the word.

Promote in Your Community Outside of School!

While you may not be able to use school property as a gathering place, there are still plenty of options for recruitment meetings. Past group leaders have hosted information sessions at public libraries, coffee shops, and community centers. We recommend nominating individual students as advocates for the trip to expand your reach; Enthusiastic parents often accommodate meetings at home.

WHO CAN JOIN MY TRIP?

Your school may have specific rules on who travels, so be sure to talk to your principal. Typically, any and all interested students within your school could be considered for inclusion. Depending on the school, parents may or may not be allowed to join in.

You may open the trip up to your school and your community, and if there are kids you know won't be a good fit for the group, it is in your right to deny their application. Talk to your principal for any specific guidelines on applications.

You have sole discretion on who travels with you. If there are kids you know won't be a good fit for the group, it is in your right to deny their application.

WHERE CAN I HAVE MY MEETINGS?

Perhaps the best benefit of a school sponsored trip is the ease of meetings. Host information sessions in your classroom conveniently during breaks or after school ends. HOW IS MY TRIP PROTECTED IN CASE OF EMERGENCY?

IS THERE A POSSIBILITY MY TRIP WILL BE CANCELLED?

If the school withdraws support, the trip is likely to be cancelled.

If the school withdraws support, there is a possibility the trip may be cancelled; however, a more likely scenario would be the trip goes forward and you would no longer be able to promote inside the school. Your travel plans will continue regardless of changes in school support. **This is the primary benefit of an independent trip.** Changes at the school board level will not affect your educational tour.
